

Kyle Annual Golf Classic – Calcutta Rules

- Being we are playing a one day tournament with teams having four players each, we will flight your teams based off of a formulated “average” of your team member’s handicap. Then the night of the Calcutta, you will pick up a copy of all flighted teams playing in the tournament with their “averaged” handicap.
- With this information, in a Calcutta, golfers bid, auction style on the team who they think will win the flight (you can bid on your own team and teams in different flights, also). All the money raised through the "auction" goes into the pot. At the end of the tournament, those who "won" the team that then won the flight get a pre-determined payout from the auction pool.
- If an individual or other team wins the bid on your team being auctioned, we will allow a player or team to buy back half of his/her team from the winning bidder. For example, your team is "won" in the auction by Team X; if this rule is in effect, you can pay half of Team X's winning bid back to Team X in order to buy back half a stake in your own team. If your team then wins the flight, your team and Team X split the Calcutta payout.
- The Kyle Chamber will automatically get 15% off the top of the pot in each flight. Payouts will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each flight at the following consecutive percentages: 60%, 30%, and 10%.
- The cash payout amount will be determined by the final auction amount in each flight. This means the more bids there are, the higher the payout!

- There is a \$25 dollar minimum for each team, and every team will be auctioned off. If no one bids on a team, the team will automatically be purchased by the Chamber, and if that team wins, the Chamber gets the proceeds.
- Last year we had three flights that each paid out for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place!
